Evaluation of the ILS in CPH (summary by Tina Hjøllund)

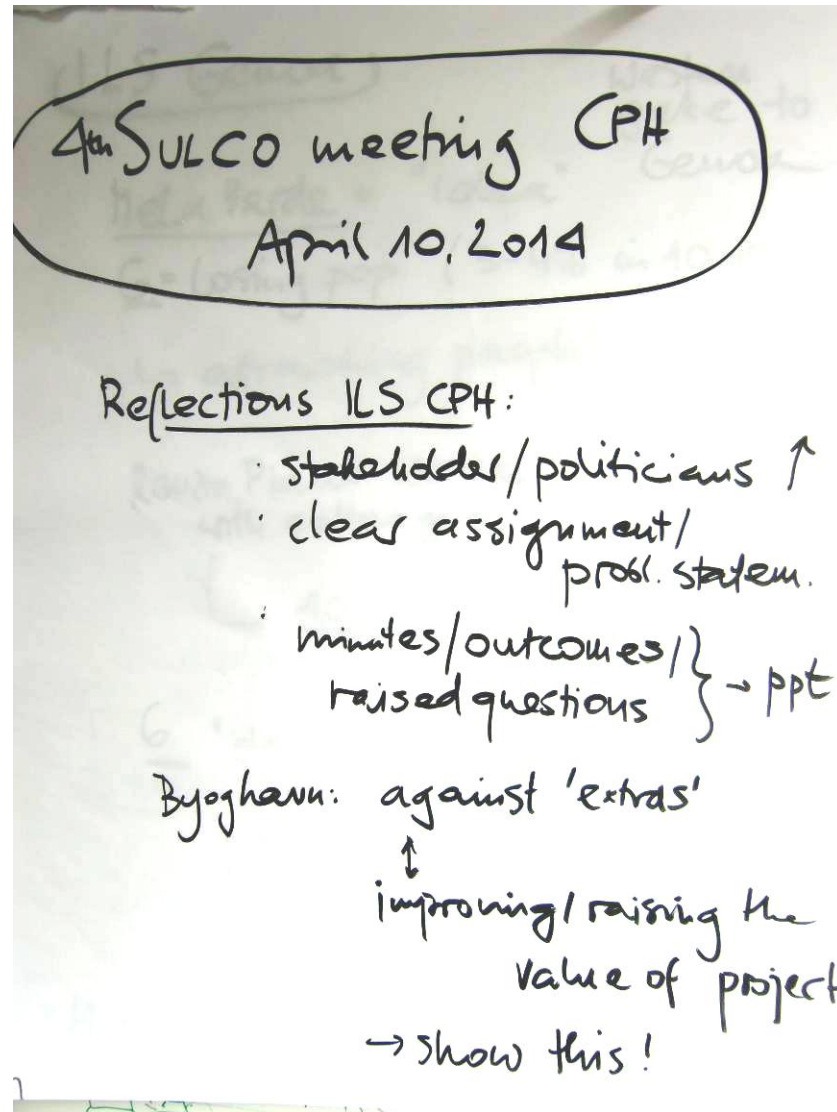

Good

A lot of people said it was very well organized.
Day 1 site visit, day 2 workshop, day 3 final presentations.
Excellent team, organization, participation and hospitality.
Good with very structured process and concrete task.
The location was cold on Wednesday, but very interesting for creative work.
Working groups said: good energy in the group, nice to have possibilities to rethink vision and have relevant stakeholders on board. Very useful and ambitious ideas.
Interesting field trip, but too short.
Good experts on day 1 and 2
Good with 3 groups
Lots of energy, clear challenge and good group dynamic.
Good with real stakeholders involved (dialogue w. developers)
Nice dining locations

To be improved:

Invite directors from the municipality to listen to the presentations on the second day.
Less general talk more specific issues.
Have a longer and more intensive exchange with stakeholder over results and recommendations.
The municipality could have asked more people from the municipality to take part in the workshops.
More time to work and discuss topics
Not much experts and stakeholders on day 3
The landowner was unfortunately missing.
Media, if the media is present it will put pressure to work hard.
Some stakeholders very not interested because of venue and framework for dialogue (no PowerPoint option and only 10-15 min. each)
Venue too cold and noisy – you lose concentration when comfort is too poor.
Even though the assignment was sent out it would have been good to repeat it on day one before visiting the SUL.
Be more honest with the specific problems in the SUL instead of making a nice presentation.
